To this end, the training course of the project Young Project Coordinators Grow Up is aimed at developing specific skills among teachers and operators of the youth associations, capable of facilitating the project activity of young people in accessing calls of European programs. With the conferral of skills, the project also intends to promote a professionalization of the human resources involved, which can be used in the workplace and for employment purposes.
